KS2 Day of Languages

This week children in Key Stage 2 took part in a Day of Languages, learning about Korea, Germany, France and Xhosa. I know that some children tried some food that they hadn't eaten before as well as learning some key phrases in new languages.

Sleep resources

As you may know, every term we do a pupil voice survey to gauge an understanding of what children think about a variety of topics and issues. This is a good opportunity for children to voice any concerns or worries and enables us to try and help them where necessary. The questions we ask come from the Anna Freud Children's Wellbeing survey.

This term, the questions focused on friendships and emotions. One of the questions also asked whether children felt that they had trouble sleeping. A significant number of children said that they 'sometimes' or 'always' had trouble sleeping and this obviously has implications for how children feel during the day.
